And we further agree to clear drafts which may be attached to the Bill of Lading covering said cargo, immediately upon the arrival of the same in Hong Kong and to forthwith deliver and surrender to you said Bill of Lading correctly endorsed, and to thereupon pay you any and all freight or other charges upon said cargo that may be due either here or which may have been unpaid by the shippers.
